

Signing the UN Global Compact (UNGC)

In April 2022, we signed the form expressing our support for the United Nations Global Compact advocated by the United Nations, and were registered as a participating company. And also we joined the United Nations Global Compact Network Japan.

The United Nations Global Compact (UNGC) is one of the largest sustainability initiatives, working in collaboration with the UN and the companies due to building the healthy global society. It is a global framework that encourages companies and organizations to take responsible and creative leadership and to act as good members of society toward attaining sustainable growth. The companies and organizations that signed the UNGC commit to support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact, concerning 4 categories about protecting human rights, eliminating unfair labor, conserving the environment and preventing corruption. In line with this commitment, the companies and organizations are asked to continually work to implement those principles.

By supporting the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact, we will further promote the management for solution of social issues and contribute to realize the healthy sustainable society.

■ The Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact

HUMAN RIGHTS

Principle 1: Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights; and

Principle 2: make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

LABOUR

Principle 3: Businesses should uphold the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining;

Principle 4: the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labour;

Principle 5: the effective abolition of child labour; and

Principle 6: the elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.



ENVIRONMENT

Principle 7: Businesses should support a precautionary approach to environmental challenges;

Principle 8: undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility; and

Principle 9: encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies.

ANTI – CORRUPTION

Principle 10: Businesses should work against corruption in all its forms, including extortion and bribery.
